GUIDELINES

The Polly Cargill Nursing Scholarship was established in honor of Polly Cargill by her sons Jerry and Jack Cargill. Applications are available at area schools of nursing or in the Foundation Office at Good Shepherd Medical Center – Marshall (903-927-6982).

Please read the following guidelines carefully:

- 1) Applicants must be a resident of one of the following East Texas Counties or Louisiana Parishes: Harrison, Anderson, Angelina, Camp, Cass, Cherokee, Gregg, Henderson, Marion, Nacogdoches, Panola, Rains, Rusk, Smith, Upshur, Van Zandt or Wood Counties and Caddo or Bossier Parishes in Louisiana.
- 2) Applicants must have a grade point average of 3.0 or above and have been accepted into a clinical nursing program or are already a nursing student in an accredited nursing program. They will be full time students. Applications will be weighted in the following order: Individuals pursuing (1) all nursing degreed programs leading to eligibility for Registered Professional Nurse licensure, (2) Bachelor of Science Degree, (3) Master of Science Degree.
- 3) Scholarships will be awarded only to those persons who commit to (1) one year of employment with Good Shepherd Medical Center - Marshall after graduation. (A position must be available, and any previous performance of duties within the hospital must have been acceptable.) An individual must apply each spring for the coming school year, even if he/she is a current awardee.
- 4) Scholarship funds may be utilized to pay tuition, fees, uniforms, books, or travel expenses.
- 5) Scholarships will be open to any person(s) regardless of race, creed, sex, religion or economic circumstances.
- 6) **All applications must be completed in full and received by Monday, May 17, 2010 no later than 5:00 pm. There will be no exceptions.** Applications may be mailed to Polly Cargill Nursing Scholarship, Marshall Hospital Foundation, P.O. Box 1947, Marshall, Texas 75671. They should be addressed to the attention of **Gayle Weinberg**.

Scholarships will be announced in June with an award ceremony to follow. The award per school year will be \$2,000.00. Funds will be distributed per semester, with \$1,000.00 awarded in June and \$1,000.00 awarded in January. Documentation from the student's school that affirms the student is in good standing and registered for the second semester must be received prior to release of the January funds. A student may apply for one semester (\$1,000.00), particularly in the event he/she has only one semester to complete before graduation.
